
Reading the Game

Remarkable Readers



This has been the first week of our new 'Remarkable Readers' initiative to celebrate the children's engagement with reading at home.

Results for Reading Journal Engagement are as follows:

Owl Class – 64% Hawk Class – 36% Kestrel Class – 60% Osprey Class – 7% Falcon Class – 65%

Falcon Class have therefore been awarded a Golden Book which they will read as a class.
