Accelerated Reader

This week we have started the process of introducing Accelerated Reader to the school. This new scheme is aimed at children who are coming to the end of their phonics journey and will stretch from approximately Year 2 all the way to Year 6.

It will motivate children to read more through engaging quizzes, goal setting, and personalised recommendations. With teachers having an enhanced understanding of the children's reading ability, children will increase their reading volume, develop greater reading stamina, word recognition, and language comprehension skills.

We are excited to introduce Accelerated Reader over the coming weeks when we will share in more detail the roll parents can play in supporting children with their reading.

Communication

Some of you will have only received last week's newsletter after the weekend. This was due to a glitch in the operating system that had blocked delivery to certain email addresses – but not all. We have been informed that this issue has now been resolved and emails should now be delivered when sent!

The school has worked exceptionally hard over the last couple of years to improve channels of communication between school and home. As a result, we can now communicate with parents via email, text, Class Dojo and social media.

The unintended consequence of our keenness to keep parents in the loop has meant that there has been a little bit of confusion as to where parents should get their information from. Next week we will share our communication strategy to clarify all.
